Equalization and Assessment Committee Minutes March 13, 2017 – 3:00 p.m.

Chairman Pemrick called the meeting to order and welcomed all in attendance.

On a motion made by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Collyer, the minutes of the February 13, 2017 meeting were approved unanimously.

A motion was made by Mr. Veitch, seconded by Mr. Barrett, to authorize the acceptance of tender offers for one parcel in the Town of Hadley totaling \$4,725.64, three parcels in the Town of Moreau totaling \$14,291.19 and one parcel in the Town of Saratoga totaling \$1,680.48. Unanimous.

Mrs. Baker said that at this point there are 56 parcels remaining on the list for the upcoming auction.

A motion was made by Mr. Collyer, seconded by Mr. Wood, to set March 21, 2017 at 3:45pm as a meeting date/time for second pulls/tender offers. Unanimous.

Mr. Dorsey gave a brief update on the Ricketts property. He spoke with Mayor Romano recently and was informed that the EPA contacted 60 homeowners about having their homes tested. 50 homeowners agreed to have their homes tested. Test results are expected within the next two weeks. Mr. Dorsey said that the property has a substantial tax lien, however the County has not taken title to the property.
