The project includes the construction for the rehabilitation of the western portion of the itinerant apron at the Saratoga County Airport (5B2). The project will include milling of partial depth of the existing asphalt and overlaying with new bituminous asphalt. The Apron geometry will be updated where the apron abuts TW A. Minor grading will occur off the edge of the apron pavement for transitioning to the existing grade of the surrounding ground. Lighting and signage will also be adjusted.

The apron was last rehabilitated in 2010 and shows signs of stress from the long winters in upstate New York. The apron is in deteriorated condition and is in need of rehabilitation to improve safety and increase longevity of use at 5B2. SARATOGA COUNTY AIRPORT

Rehabilitation of Western Itinerant Apron (Construction)

Category I: airport development or terminal development projects, including planning for such development.

Project Narrative

The project includes the construction for the rehabilitation of the western portion of the itinerant apron at the Saratoga County Airport (5B2). The project will include milling of partial depth of the existing asphalt and overlaying with new bituminous asphalt. The Apron geometry will be updated where the apron abuts TW A. Minor grading will occur off the edge of the apron pavement for transitioning to the existing grade of the surrounding ground. Lighting and signage will be adjusted to accommodate new pavement geometry.

Justification

The apron was last rehabilitated in 2010 and shows signs of stress from the long winters in upstate New York. The apron is in deteriorated condition and is in need of rehabilitation to improve safety and increase longevity of use at 5B2. Minor changes to pavement geometry is proposed to bring the connection to Taxiway A up to current standards. The proposed improvements are anticipated to be funded through the Airport Improvement Program (AIP) on land that was acquired using a combination of funding through AIP and the Airport Development Aid Program (ADAP). A CATEX was issued by the FAA NYADO on 11/8/22.






