10. Remarks:

The Board accepted BridgeNY Culvert funding for this project as part of Resolution 115 of 2022. BridgeNY Culvert grant funds are capped and any costs that exceed the grant amount must be borne by the County. The grant award included \$697,600 for construction and the budget amendment makes up the difference of \$283,545 for the contract award of \$981,145.

Cost escalations can be attributed to changes in NYSDOT asphalt and concrete specifications since this project was estimated in 2021, staged construction vs. an on-site detour that was originally anticipated and difficulties in sourcing available precast concrete for this project.

1) (2) Each NYS DEC Unpermitted Discharge Actions Plus Consent Order R4-2018-1218-210 relate to the storage of bulk road salt at the Cocymans Recycling Center, LLC Facility (Case No. NYR00F372). It was determined by NYSDEC during a routine inspection that the bulk road salt piles that were stored on site and covered by larps were "Large Piles" and therefore the storm water coverage within our multi-sector general permit (MSGP) did not apply. We contend that we followed best practices within our MSGP, however NYSDEC disagreed. Ultimatley a consent order was agreed upon, we built 2 buildings to move the salt indoors, and no bulk road salt is stored on the Cocymans Recycling Center, LLC site at this time, and the consent order is closed. 2) The EPA inspection resulted in minor findings, and no penalty that were all rectified as detailed in the response letter, we continue to monitor these areas monthly and address any issues found. 3) The Carver Sand & Gravel, LLC Order on Consent was regarding mining within our quarry in Middleburgh NY. The blasting benching process resulted in mining over the allowable area, while still within the life of mine. Previously only the life of mine was physically staked out as required by our permit, however now all benches are clearly marked with the blasting limits. 4) The Solid Waste Order on Consent for Cocymans Recycling Center, LLC R4-2018-1217-213 was regarding the change in classification of recycled concrete aggregate from a beneficial use to a solid waste, this is currently under enforcement discretion with NYSDEC and we are working closely to monitor the outcome of new regulations. We have applied for closure of this consent order and are awaiting response from NYSDEC. 5) MSHA Violation #9414650 was regarding an operator that we moved from one of our satellite locations to our main quarry. This individual was tasked trained but it was not documented, and the individual was incorrectly digging into a pile of shot rock on 9/26/2018 resulting in a violation due to the in

The Contractor shall purchase and maintain such insurance as will protect him from all claims as set forth below, which may arise out of or result from the Contractor's operations under the Contract, whether such operations be by himself or any subcontractor or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them or by anyone for whose acts any of them may be liable:

- 1. claims under workmen's compensation, disability benefit and other similar employee benefit acts;
- 2. claims for damages because of bodily injury, occupational sickness or disease, or death of his employees;

Bodily Injury and Property Damage – completed job operation and/or products liability at before mentioned limits with \$1,000,000 for bodily injury and \$1,000,000 aggregate for operations, protection, contractual and products and/or completed job operations. Property Damage shall be on the broad form and shall include coverage for explosion, collapse and underground damages.

The above insurance is not, and shall not be construed as, a limitation upon CONTRACTOR's obligation to indemnify the COUNTY.

This clause shall not be construed to limit, or otherwise impair, other rights or obligations of indemnity which exist in law, or in equity, for the benefit of the COUNTY.
