Trails Grant Reserve Fund Transfer

The following grant is preparing for reimbursement and transfers must be made from the Trails Reserve Fund (A-0888.TR) to the Municipal Planning Trails Grant Program (A.80.000-8492.9) to facilitate the reimbursement:

1. 2023 Town of Malta (awarded via Resolution 216-2023) - \$10,000

2024 County Trails Grants (Board Resolution will be required depending on Committee Recommendation)

The 2024 Municipal Trails Grant applications have been received from 15 different municipalities totaling \$148,000.00. The 15 requests have a total project cost of \$347,387.52. The total budgeted amount for 2024 is \$150,000. A summary of the applications is listed below:

Town of Ballston

Jenkins Park Trail Extension & Existing Trail Restoration Amount Requested \$10,000 A proposal to construct 885 ft. of trail extension on the existing 2.5 mile trail network within the existing Townowned, 43-acre, multi-use recreational park. An additional proposal to restore 2,450 l.f. of the existing trails with re-surfacing and drainage repairs.

Town of Charlton

LaRue Creek Covered Bridge Replacement

Amount Requested \$10,000

A proposal to replace a covered bridge that expands LaRue Creek and is part of the Saratoga County Snowmobile trail network. The bridge will be replaced with a 50 ft x 8 ft x 7 ft covered bridge.

Town of Clifton Park

Trail Boardwalk Restoration: Brookhaven to Park Lane Estates Amount Requested \$10,000 A proposal to repair/restore the existing 17-year-old pedestrian boardwalk section of the existing trail route that traverses wetlands on the south side of a steel bridge that expands the Dwaas Kill. This trail connects with

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other local trails that connect residential neighborhoods with public parks, school areas and commercial ventures in Town.

Town of Corinth

Trail Network/9N property

Amount Requested \$10,000

A proposal to fund Phase I of the Town's Master Plan of town-owned property to be utilized as a recreational park. Phase I will include the design, layout and possibly material for 1.6 miles of planned trails in the park.

Village of Corinth

Upgrade Corinth Recreational Area Trails

Amount Requested \$8,000

A proposal to provide a feasibility study and trail amenities such as: new kiosk in the parking lot, benches along the trail, new trail head markers and new trail identification markers along the Village's existing Upper Reservoir trail network.

Town of Hadley

Tennis Court/Basketball Course Refurbishing

Amount Requested \$10,000

A proposal to refurbish existing tennis and basketball courts and replace some fencing surrounding the tennis courts in the Town Park.

Town of Halfmoon

Erie Canalway Trail Paving

Amount Requested \$10,000

A proposal to pave a portion of the Town's Mohawk Towpath Scenic Byway or more specifically, 1,200 l.f. of existing stone dust trail from Whites Lane to the Crescent Boat Club.

Town of Malta

Malta Community Park Trail Restoration

Amount Requested \$10,000

A proposal to refurbish a 0.62-mi. nature trail of the 22.69-acre Malta Community Park with engineered wood fiber. Also, existing wayfinding signage will be replaced with new signage with requested grant funds.

Town of Moreau

Big Bend Trail Phase I Completion: Trail Amenities

Amount Requested \$10,000

To provide an accessible kayak launch in the Hudson River from the Town's Phase I of the Big Bend Trail.

Town of Northumberland

Meadow in the Sky Trail - Hudson Point Crossing

Amount Requested \$10,000

In 2023 Hudson Crossing Park completed phase I of Meadow in the Sky trail with a segment of "Allee of Oaks" of 7 different varieties of Oak trees. A proposal for Phase II, of which funding is being sought, would provide over 50 understory, native species of plants in between the Oaks that will provide ecological benefits to the area.

Town of Saratoga

Town-wide Restoration & Maintenance Project

Amount Requested \$10,000

The Town wishes to resurface several trails including trails connected to the Siege Trail, the Champlain Canal Trail, the Town's Boat Launch trail and one more that connects to the Town of Stillwater with stone dust and fine rubble with emphasis on maintenance where trails are worn or washed out.

City of Saratoga Springs

Bog Meadow Brook Nature Trail Improvements

Amount Requested \$10,000

A proposed improvement to the existing trail network due to the original improvements from the trail in 1993 are now over 30 years old: Fix parking lot pot holes on both Rt 29 and Meadowbrook Road parking lots, repair drainage issues in the Route 20 parking lot as well as Gilbert Road, perform maintenance on culverts and or add new culverts between the Rt 29 parking lot and the bridge over the Bog Meadow Brook, replace or refurbish aging trail identification signs throughout the trail.

Village of South Glens Falls

Betar Byway Public Restroom (Upper Trailhead)

Amount Requested \$10,000

A proposal to place an ADA-compliant portable toilet facility that connects to municipal water and sewer. The proposed restroom facility will be placed on the Village's DPW lands in the upper section of the existing trail.

Village of Stillwater

Village of Stillwater Pedestrian Park

Amount Requested \$10,000

The Village intends to construct a Village overlook park on property neighboring the Stillwater Blockhouse. The project will include the creation of an expanded parking area, walkways and a Hudson River overlook constructed of Alaskan cement slab with stainless steel posts & cables.

Town of Wilton

Northern Pines Rd. fishing access parking & trail

Amount Requested \$10,000

A proposal to provide a parking lot and trail access to the Snook Kill off of Northern Pines Rd. to provide fishing access for Veterans Housing Community and general public. Funds will be used to provide grading of raw land and purchase of parking and trail construction materials.

NYS Snowmobile Grant Application

On behalf of the Saratoga County Association of Snowmobile Clubs, the Planning and Economic Development Department is requesting acceptance by the Trails and Open Space Committee – and to be forwarded to the Board of Supervisors – an application for a NYS Snowmobile Trail Grant-in-Aid Program estimated not to exceed \$80,000. These are pass through funds that go directly to the clubs of the Saratoga County Association of Snowmobile Clubs, so there is no budget impact.

According to the 2023-2024 NYS OPRHP Snowmobile Season Report, based on information received from the Department of Motor Vehicles, 79,727 snowmobiles were registered in New York State during the 2023-24 season. \$3,976,630 was collected in registration fees.

The Snowmobile Trail Grant-In-Aid Program establishes a mechanism for allocating funds to local governmental sponsors who engage in the development and maintenance of snowmobile trails designated as part of the State Snowmobile Trail System. There are 10,522 miles of trails in 45 counties serving 52 local municipalities and over 220 TMEs (Snowmobile Clubs). NYS has a maximum total award of \$4,843,245 allocated for the 2024-2025 grant cycle.

Since 1994 Saratoga County has served as the Local Municipal Sponsor for the NYS Snowmobile Trails Grant-in-Aid Program administered by NYS OPRHP. The Saratoga County Association of Snowmobile Clubs (comprised of

the Charlton, Country Trailblazers, Galway, Lincoln Mountain, and the Saratoga Snowmobile Association) develops, maintains, and operates 181 miles of state grant-funded trails through 19 municipalities within Saratoga County. The trail mileage proposed for the 2024-2025 season is the same as what was finalized for the 2023-2024 season.

In the 2023-2024 season the Saratoga County Association of Snowmobile Clubs spent \$87,268.50 for equipment, signs and materials, groomer usage, and miscellaneous expenses. The Saratoga County Association of Snowmobile Clubs received \$69,504 through the grant program and distributed the funds to each club based on mileage.

Permission is received from landowners for the clubs to operate the trail system on their respective properties. Municipal and county approval is necessary where those trails cross or occupy the local or county right of way. A map and mileage chart are attached to the memo. There is no cost to the individual landowners to operate the trail system. Additionally, the grant program creates no budget impact to Saratoga County as snowmobile registrations fund 100% of the grant awards. These funds are received from NYS and passed on to the snowmobile clubs in Saratoga County.

County Forestland / Zim Smith Trail Updates / County Grant Updates

- There are currently 9 pending Open Space/Farmland Protection Projects, including the three 2024 awards, 3 from 2023, 1 from 2022, and 2 from 2021.
- Currently, there are 15 pending Trail Projects being administered by the Planning Department. Of the 15 projects, 8 are 2023 awards, 5 are 2022, one is 2021 and one is 2020. The Town of Malta has submitted for reimbursement for their 2023 grant.
- The Town of Moreau recently completed the crosswalk on Butler Road that will connect the County Forestland with the recently opened Big Bend Preserve. Materials were provided by Saratoga County and the Town of Moreau DPW performed the work.
- Supervisor Grasso and Jason Kemper attended the ribbon cutting event for the Big Bend Preserve. The event was well attended and numerous speakers commended the efforts of Saratoga County with connecting the County Forestland to this recently opened state park.
- Zim Smith North Updates Zim Smith North Design and landowner outreach continues to move forward. Meetings have been held with the NYSDOT and FHA to discuss future funding possibilities and the phasing of the trail construction/permitting.
- Zim Smith Sewer Work The sewer district has completed the repaving of the Zim Smith Trail, some minor punch list items are being wrapped up and the project will be completed.

AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE COUNTY TRAILS DEVELOPMENT RESERVE FUND AND AMENDING THE 2024 COUNTY BUDGET IN RELATION THERETO

WHEREAS, upon receipt of a reimbursement voucher from the municipal applicant funds will be appropriated to the General Fund budget from the County Trails Development Reserve for reimbursement to the municipal applicant; and

WHEREAS, unexpended grant funds for the 2023 Town of Malta grants total \$10,000; and

WHEREAS, reimbursement requests have been submitted by the Town of Malta for the grant project previously approved in 2023; and

WHEREAS, the transfer of funds from the County Trails Development Reserve to the Saratoga County Trails Grant Program account for disbursement to municipal applicants require this Board's approval and an associated amendment to the 2024 County Budget; and

WHEREAS, our Trails and Open Space Committee and the Director of Planning and Economic Development have recommended that \$10,000 be transferred from the County Trails Development Reserve to the Saratoga County Trails Grant Program account; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this Board authorizes the transfer of \$10,000 from the County Trails Development Reserve funds to the Saratoga County Trails Grant Program; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Budget Officer is hereby authorized to enter the appropriate journal entries to reflect the approved budget transfer; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the 2024 County Budget is hereby amended as follows:

Introduced by Trails and Open Space: Supervisors Grasso, Connolly, Madigan, Kinowski, and M. Veitch

AWARDING 2024 TRAILS GRANTS

WHEREAS, the 2024 Saratoga County Budget included a Trails Grant Program to give matching grants to local municipalities to fund trail development and construction projects; and

WHEREAS, the 2024 Trails Grant Program provides a pool of up to \$150,000 to fund trail feasibility studies, engineering work, and construction in local municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the Trails and Open Space Committee received fifteen applications for funding totaling \$148,000, which the Committee recommended to be fully funded; and

WHEREAS, our Trails and Open Space Committee and Law and Finance Committee approved fully funding all twelve applications submitted, at a cost of \$148,000 utilizing allotted 2024 Trails Grant funds; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Saratoga County Board of Supervisors authorizes the payment under the 2024 Trails Grant Program of the sum of \$148,000 to the following municipalities for the purposes stated, upon condition that each municipality provide matching funds or services inkind:

- 1. **Town of Ballston:** The amount of \$10,000 to be applied towards the Jenkins Park Trail Extension & Existing Trail Restoration to include the construction of 885 ft. of trail extension on the existing 2.5 mile trail network within the existing Town-owned, 43-acre, multi-use recreational park and restoration of 2,450 l.f. of the existing trails with resurfacing and drainage repairs.
- 2. **Town of Charlton:** The amount of \$10,000 to be applied towards the LaRue Creek Covered Bridge Replacement to include replacement of a covered bridge that expands LaRue Creek and is part of the Saratoga County Snowmobile trail network. The bridge will be replaced with a 50 ft x 8 ft x 7 ft covered bridge.
- 3. **Town of Clifton Park:** The amount of \$10,000 to be applied towards the Trail Boardwalk Restoration: Brookhaven to Park Lane Estates to include a repair/restoration of the existing 17-year old pedestrian boardwalk section of the existing trail route that traverses wetlands on the south side of a steel bridge that expands the Dwaas Kill. This

- 14. 
