#### **Timber Harvest**

The Planning and Economic Development Department has been preparing for the 2024/25 timber harvest that will occur in the Town of Northumberland on Parcel #129.-1-15. Site visits have been performed with the Chairman of the Trails and Open Space Committee and Town Supervisor. A letter was mailed to adjoining property owners on 9.5.24 explaining the timber harvest and advising that a survey would also be completed to re-establish the county forestland boundary. A letter will be sent to the neighbors prior to the commencement of the harvest.

Field work for the survey will be completed by 9.27.24. The parcel will be harvested in two phases, the perimeter of the parcel will be harvested with this bid. The remaining portion of the parcel will be marked for a timber sale this fall and bids sent out in winter of 2025 with a late winter 2025 award date. Both timber harvest projects must be completed by December 31<sup>st</sup> of 2025. Timber bids were mailed to several companies and two responses were received for the bid opening. Two bids were received, the winning bid was awarded to 3B timber in the amount of \$52,006.41. The resolution will award the contract to the second bidder (Prentiss and Carlisle \$42,313.00) if the winning bidder cannot complete the project.

#### Zim Smith Trail North Project update

Greenman Pederson Engineering PLLC will provide an update at the meeting on the Zim Smith North Project. The summary will include project status, grant funding received, outreach to neighbors, coordination with NYSDOT and FHWA and a summary on rough estimates for the extension of Zim Smith North to the Saratoga Spa State Park.

#### County Forestland / Zim Smith Trail Updates / County Grant Updates

- There are currently 9 pending Open Space/Farmland Protection Projects, including the three 2024 awards, 3 from 2023, 1 from 2022, and 2 from 2021.
- Currently, there are 14 pending Trail Projects being administered by the Planning Department. Of the 14 projects, 7 are 2023 awards, 5 are 2022, one is 2021 and one is 2020. Additionally, there are fifteen (15) 2024 Trail grant projects awarded by the Board of Supervisors on August 20, 2024.
- The annual AML-303b Agricultural District Inclusion application is on the Saratoga County Planning Website and the Public Notice has been posted in the official county newspapers. for the upcoming 30day Agricultural District inclusion period beginning October 1, 2024 to October 31, 2024. The annual 30day inclusion period allows county landowners, with viable agricultural land, to petition the county to include their land within one of the two county agricultural districts. The Department has received several inquiries from interested landowners wanting to add their lands to an agricultural district.
- The County will be installing a new entrance sign for the county forestland on Redmond Road to aid in parking for trail and equine users.
- Saratoga PLAN presented the county a Conservation Hero award for the county's efforts on the Graphite Range Community Forest. Supervisor Grasso and Jason Kemper were in attendance at the event to accept the award on behalf of Saratoga County.

#### AUTHORIZING A LOGGING REVENUE AGREEMENT WITH 3B TIMBER CO, INC. FOR A TIMBER HARVEST ON A COUNTY OWNED PARCEL IN THE TOWN OF NORTHUMBERLAND

**WHEREAS**, the County owns forest land located on Taylor Road in the Town of Northumberland, which parcels have been inventoried and selected for harvest in accordance with the County's Forestry Management Plan and in consultation with the county forestor;

**WHEREAS**, the parcel, known and designated as Tax Parcel #129.-1-15, #, encompasses approximately 75 acres of harvest area; and

**WHEREAS**, the highest bid received was a lump sum timber harvest bid submitted by 3B Timber Co, Inc. . in the amount of \$52,006.41; and

**WHEREAS**, the second highest bid was a lump sum timber harvest bid submitted by Prentiss and Carlisle Management Company, Inc. in the amount of \$\$42,313.00; and

**WHEREAS**, our Trails and Open Space Committee, the County's Director of Planning and Economic Development and the County Forester recommend that the bid of 3B Timber Co., Inc. be accepted; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, that the Chair of the Board is authorized to execute an agreement with 3B Timber Company, , Inc. of Booneville, New York, for the selective harvesting of timber on approximately 75 acres of County forest land in the Town of Northumberland, identified herein as Tax Parcel #129.-1-15, for which 3B Timber Company, Inc., Inc. will pay to the County the sum of \$52,006.13 for the harvested timber; and it is further

**RESOLVED**, that in the event that 3B Timber Company Inc, , Inc. withdraws their bid or otherwise cannot meet the contract requirements, the Chair of the Board is authorized to enter into an agreement with the underbidder, Prentiss and Carlisle Management Company, Inc. Saranac Lake, New York, for the selective harvesting of timber on approximately 75 acres of County forest land in the Town of Northumberland , identified herein as Tax Parcels #129.-1-15, for which Prentiss and Carlisle Management Company, Inc. , will pay to the County the sum of \$42,313.00 for the harvested timber, without further legislative approval being required; and it is further **RESOLVED**, that the form and content of any agreements shall be subject to the approval of the County Attorney; and it is further

**RESOLVED**, that the 2024 County Budget is amended as follows:

Dear Landowner:

You are receiving this letter as an adjacent landowner to Saratoga County Forestland (SBL # 129.-1-15). This letter is to inform you that in accordance with County Reforestation Law (Section 219), Saratoga County will be completing a timber harvest on the lands adjoining your property. The access for the timber harvest will occur on Taylor Road.

The timber harvest will be a thinning project broken into two phases. The first phase is currently out to bid, with a bid award occurring this fall. The second phase generally covering the interior of the parcel will be put out to bid during the winter/spring of 2025. All work will be completed by winter 2025. Attached to this letter is a map illustrating the approximate harvest limits of the project. Upon completion of the harvest the main trails on the property will be restored to allow for continued recreational opportunities on the parcel.

Please refrain from entering the woods during the harvest operation and seeking information from the contractors. Saratoga County utilizes a forestry consultant to mark the timber and manage the timber sale. The contractor performing the harvest operations performs the work at the direction of the forestry consultant and Saratoga County. In addition, Saratoga County will be completing a boundary line survey to verify the boundary line of the County Forestland parcel.

Saratoga County manages approximately 3000 acres of county forestland across several municipalities. Timber harvest occurs on these parcels on a rotational basis. Saratoga County's sustainable timber harvest practices help to maintain forest health and biodiversity including reducing the risk of wildfires, promoting new growth, and enhancing habitats for wildlife. Prior to the commencement of any harvest, Saratoga County will send a notice to the adjoining property owners advising them of the schedule for timber harvest.


